M4 ADD ON MAGNETIC OPTION Instructions and Warnings

Warning: Do not use this product if you cannot understand and follow the instructions and warnings that come with it and complete all necessary functions.

The M4 Add On Magnet Option is a multi-use device that can be easily attached or removed from various types of Full Body Harnesses, Saddles or Belts. It can be used for stowing the connecting hardware at the parked end of your lanyard when not in use. The hardware will release at a force of less than 120 lb. in the event the lanyard is snagged on an object as required by the ANSI Z359.11 Standard. Another use is for stowing small metallic parts, fasteners, etc. for easy access while at a work location. These instructions show attachment to a harness for clarity purposes.

The M4 Add On Magnet Option is shown open and closed below in Fig. 1.

Note: Color / options may vary from those shown.

Attachment to a Harness

1. Open and unfold the Add On Option by separating the hook from the loop fastener (Fig.1).
2. Determine the location where you want to attach the Add On Option. The red lines in Figure 2 indicate the ideal location to mount if used for a Lanyard Parking Attachment.
3. Slide the Add On Option with the hook fastener facing down under the harness shoulder strap. (If harness is equipped with a back pad, slide the Add On Option between the strap and the pad (Fig 3)).
4. Fold the Add On Option over the top of the harness shoulder strap (Fig4).
5. Slide the hook fastener under the harness shoulder strap and adhere it to the loop fastener (Fig. 5).

6. When properly attached the Add On Option should appear as shown in Figure 5. Figure 6 shows the attached Add On Option used for a Lanyard Parking Attachment.

- M4 Add On Magnet Option must never be used for fall protection of any kind.
- Not be installed where it can interfere with the operation of any other hardware, attachment or connection points of the harness, saddle or belt.
- Oversized or multiple connectors must not be attached as they may cause the M4 Add On Magnet Option to slide from its original position.
- Only Buckingham Mfg. Co. or those people authorized in writing by Buckingham Mfg. Co. may make repairs to this product.
- M4 Add On Magnet Option should not be resold / redistributed or re-used after use by original user.
- Always use caution when working near machinery or moving parts. Loose items can hang and become inadvertently entangled.

- When not in use, store to prevent exposure to the elements as well as over exposure to sunlight (U.V. degradation).
- Avoid contact of this product with chemicals that may damage the material. If in doubt, contact Buckingham Mfg. Co.
- Never modify tool this or any other product.

Inspection

- Prior to each use, inspect the M4 Add On Magnet Option for damage / deficiencies.
- Deficiencies of webbing, stitching, and other soft materials include, but are not limited to, fraying, broken stitching, loose stitching, alterations, abrasions, excessive wear, cuts, burns, charring, broken fibers, and chemical exposures.
- Immediately remove from service if defects or damage are found.

Maintenance, Cleaning, and Storage

- Proper maintenance and storage of your equipment will prolong its useful life and contribute toward its performance.
- M4 Add On Magnet Option should be cleaned with water and mild soap (a dish washing soap that removes grease (i.e. Dawn)) and be allowed to dry thoroughly without using excessive heat.
- When not in use, store M4 Add On Magnet Option where it will not be affected by heat, light, moisture, chemicals, or other corrosive elements.

NOTE: Ensure proper fit / size of product before use. This product **cannot** be returned unless it is in new / unused condition.

STATEMENT of OBSOLESCENCE:

Precise “useful life expectancy” or “shelf life” for this product is not specified, as the degree of use, conditions of use, and the degree of care and storage determines useful life. All users maintain responsibility to select proper equipment for the job, be properly trained in its use, and ensure all personnel support equipment passes inspection before each use.
